COMPETITION INFORMATION

The **Hong Kong Jockey Club RESTART Rising Stars** provides owners the opportunity to showcase the potential of their recently retired racehorse. The judges will be looking for potential for the future: an athletic, loose moving horse with a promising jumping technique and attitude, which with correct training will develop physically and mentally into a top-level three-day eventer.

INTRODUCTION

Supported by Hong Kong Jockey Club and conducted by the Melbourne International 3 Day Event Committee (on behalf of Eventing Victoria) in accordance with EA Guidelines.

Competition date: Friday 7 June 2024

Timetables (including Arena familiarisation) will be posted after close of entries. It is highly recommended competitors attend the Arena familiarisation.

Competitors please note: All riders are required to check in at the Event Office upon arrival to the grounds at Werribee Park. Riders will receive two Friday passes for event access.

Riders must have a minimum of Participant membership with Equestrian Australia.

Prizes: 1st Place: Rosette/Sash, Trophy Rug & prizemoney \$600

2nd Place: Rosette plus prize money \$400 3rd Place: Rosette plus prize money \$200

4th - 6th Place: Rosette

Entry Fee:

\$150 (Inc GST) per horse includes WPNEC facility fee for Friday 7 June, medical levy & admin. fee Additional facility fees must be paid if staying additional days.

Entry fee includes 2 Friday access passes to MI3DE.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and may be restricted if the class is oversubscribed.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Dressage: Each horse performs a dressage test to demonstrate obedience, suppleness and correct, elastic and regular gaits. Note: whips may NOT be carried in the dressage test. Dressage test see below.

Jumping: the course will be a combined solid obstacle & show jumps. A hand gallop will also be expected. Rider attire as for cross country. Dress: Safety vest for jumping phase but no back numbers, use bridle numbers. Jump height maximum 80cm

Dress and Saddlery:

*Approved safety helmets are to be worn in all ridden phases.

The winner will have the highest overall marks from the two sections.

General Conditions:

- Competitions are conducted under EA National guidelines
- All riders and owners must be EA registered, minimum participant membership
- Riders must turn 12 years of age or over in the calendar year of competition
- Tests may not be called
- Competitions are official but do not attract grading points
- The same judges will not necessarily officiate in each round
- All scratchings must be advised via email

Competitors are bound by the Equestrian Australia (EA) General Regulations, applicable EA Sport Rules and all relevant EA Codes, policies, bylaws, rules and regulations.

Stable priority is given to the horses competing in the Long Format classes, please contact Event Secretary <u>susan mckay@bigpond.com</u> to enquire about stable availability.

Overnight camping is available and must be booked and paid for at the time of entry. Powered sites are \$40 per night, Unpowered sites \$25 Day visitors will park in the K Road parking area

Cancellation and Refund

- EV or the Organising Committee may cancel the event due to catastrophic conditions, disease or force majeure, or for any other reason at its absolute discretion.
- If the event is cancelled after it has commenced there will be no refunds. If
 the event is cancelled prior to commencement the entrant may be entitled
 to a proportional refund of the entry fees paid. Any such refund will be
 determined at the absolute discretion of EV, having regard to the direct or
 fixed costs for the event.
- Entrants who have provided with their entry an email address and/or mobile phone number will be notified of event cancellation by email and/or text message.

- In consideration of acceptance of your entry and participation in the event, you agree to indemnify and keep indemnified EA, EV, their servants and agents and the Organising Committee and each member thereof against all claims, proceedings or demands brought by or on behalf of any participant or competitor named in your entry form for any loss or damage howsoever arising from any accident or incident occurring at the event.

Child Safe Event

All Equestrian Victoria competitions are governed under Victoria's Child Safe Legislation. It is expected of all competitors, parents and spectators to participate under these guidelines.

Trot work may be rising or sitting

- A Enter at working trot
- C Track left
- E Turn left
- X 20m circle left
- X 20m circle right
- B Turn right

KXM Change rein

Between C and H canter left

E 20m circle left

FXH Change rein - X trot

Between C and M canter right

B 20m circle right

Between B and F working trot

- A Circle right 20m allowing horse to stretch downwards and forwards
- A Working trot
- E Medium walk
- SR Half 20m circle free walk on long rein

Before R Medium walk

- R Working Trot
- B Half circle right 10 metres
- X Down centre line
- G Halt
