Dear Competitors

As per the FEI Schedule stables will open on Wednesday 4 June at 12.00pm.

For horses attending FEI events, rectal temperatures must be taken and recorded twice daily in the FEI HorseApp. More information [FEI Temperature Checks](#) If you have any additional horses travelling they must also have their temperature taken and recorded.

Horses:

On arrival, all horses, (including non-competition horses), are required to present for a vet examination before being stabled. In 2025 Arrival Vet checks are timetabled:

CCI4*-L Stabling: As required by the FEI, horses entered in the CCI4*L will be stabled in a secure area. Your other competition horses will be nearby. A security attendant will monitor the CCI4* stable area between 6am and 10pm. Outside these hours, admission is arranged with the Steward or Stable Manager camped at the entrance to this area.

A Competitor Car Pass is included in your Rider Pack. This Car Pass is not transferable and is for your vehicle only. **ONLY** vehicles displaying this official car pass will be permitted into the stable area. If you have not booked a camp site please ensure you do not park in an allocated site, there are unreserved spaces available out the back of the stabling area. Please adhere to this arrangement throughout the event to ensure our OH&S requirements are met.

Riders:

Riders, please check in at the Event Office (at the end of the main Office Building) and collect your rider information pack and accreditation passes. Wristbands must be secured and displayed at all times. You will be required to sign off for these items as they cannot be re-issued. During the event please check for notices on the Competition Office noticeboard.

Veterinary Treatment: During the event if your horse requires veterinary treatment & supplies it is requested that payment be made to the Vet at the time of treatment. Your attention to this will be appreciated by our Veterinary Services team.

Note to WA competitors: WA riders who will need liver fluke tests done so they can go home afterwards need to bring their own Fasinex or arrange to have that treatment done at the border on the way home if they need it.

Stable Bedding: If you require additional bedding during the event please contact Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre on 03 9741 7672, their office is located on the Main Drive at the venue. Please order before 1pm for same day delivery. All stables will be supplied with 7 bales of shavings. Horses in non CCI/CCN classes who have been allocated a stable must pay for their stable and bedding at the MI3DE Competition office on arrival.

Camping Note: Each powered campsite can run **ONE** lead, please do not piggy back. It is important we do not overload the power available as the whole area will go out. Please consider everyone of the venue.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS – especially 3* & 4* - **Walking the Cross-Country Course**

Once cross-country competition begins on Sunday, riders walking the XC course **must** be wearing their competition back number and may **ONLY** be accompanied by **ONE** other person, (coach/groom). Due to the safety risk for riders and horses on course this requirement will be monitored by officials and any breaches will be managed appropriately.

Dress Code

Please ensure your riding attire meets FEI standards and regulations

Stable Cleaning

Wheelbarrows will be available to use when cleaning stables. Please empty wheelbarrows at the end of stable rows. The manure pit is at the Mansion Hotel end of the stable blocks, **not** the indoor arena end. There will be no push ups during the event.

Please do not dump your stable droppings in the laneways, it blocks the drains.

Manure pick up – please pick up the manure in the waxed arenas and place in bins provided.

Presentations

On Monday presentations for each class will be made immediately following the end of the class. If you are in contention for a placing, please ensure you are available when required. Please follow marshalls directions.

House Rules

Please keep noise and party atmosphere to an acceptable level – your horses are close by and are trying to rest. Please respect your fellow riders; some are competing early the next day.

Competitors, we ask you kindly to please keep your dogs 'back of house' in the stabling/camping area and on a lead. Parks Victoria do not allow dogs upon their land and while WPNEC allow dogs at the Equestrian Centre our use of Parks Victoria land is jeopardised by dogs being out on the cross-country course.
