Stabling:

Stable Fees: \$280 includes – WPNEC cleaning fee, stable manager fee.

The Stabling fee includes cleaning on departure.

The Stabling fee does not include bedding, it is shown as a separate item.

All stables will be padlocked at the time of your arrival. Please report to the Stable Manager for access. Stabling is available for competing horses only, from 1.00pm arrival on Wednesday 3 June 2026.

Please note: we cannot guarantee stables for use as tack rooms. Competitors should bring stable cleaning gear to move manure the manure pit.

Horse arrivals are scheduled for Wednesday 3 June. Any horses arriving earlier are required to pay additional facility fees (\$20 p.d.) at the time of entry. STABLING PRIORITY is given to CCI horses

Stable Bedding:

Bedding Fee: \$100 - all stables will contain 7 bales of shavings for spreading on your arrival. Bales will be opened in the stables prior to your arrival to avoid any going missing. **If you are bringing your own stable bedding you must 'opt out' when completing your entry on Event Secretary.** You will be refunded the bedding fee after close of entries. Please email susan_mckay@bigpond.com if you are bringing your own stable bedding.

Stable Bedding can be purchased during the event from WPNEC (03 9741 7672) at \$14.50 per bale. To ensure same day delivery bedding orders must be placed with WPNEC by 12.00pm each day.

COMPETITOR INFORMATION Cont.,**Hendra Vaccination & Bio Security Policy for horses attending Melbourne International 3 Day Event:**

There are currently no movement requirements or certification required for horses moving from interstate into Victoria. However, please be advised that we are a HENDRA event. Livestock (including horses) affected or suspected of being affected with a notifiable disease may not enter the State unless authorised by the Chief Inspector of Stock.

The organising committee reserves the right to not accept entries where horses from Hendra affected areas are not vaccinated.

EADMCP

The FEI's swabbing program will run concurrently to EA's anti-doping and controlled medication program. Each horse entered into an FEI event will incur the FEI's Worldwide Equine and Human Anti-Doping program fee. You will be required to pay this to the Organising Committee at the time entry.

Each horse competing in a lower level event will be charged AUD \$38

Each horse competing in a higher level event will be charged AUD \$55

EVENT CANCELLATION POLICY:

Equestrian Victoria or the Organising Committee may cancel the event due to catastrophic conditions, disease or force majeure, or for any other reason at its absolute discretion. If the event is cancelled prior to commencement, for whatever reason, any refund will be determined at the absolute discretion of Equestrian Victoria, having regard to the direct or fixed costs for the event. This includes State, Territory or Commonwealth government travel restrictions, COVID-19 quarantine and isolation requirements. Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre Committee of Management considers it a **privilege** that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. We insist you **keep your dog on a leash and under effective control** at all times.

1. Approved Safety Helmets must be always worn when riding
2. Cross Country obstacles must not be jumped/used unless a non-riding level one NCAS coach is present.
3. Riding of horses bareback is
4. Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is
5. Any person may lead a maximum of two horses while
6. Stallions must always be in the control of a person aged eighteen (18) years or
7. Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1).
8. Horses are not permitted near pedestrian
9. Straw bedding is not permitted on the venue. Only wood shavings/sawdust bedding is accepted.
10. Helmets must be worn when riding bikes or unpowered scooters.
11. Bicycles are not permitted in the indoor arenas or any stable block.
12. Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits.
13. Electric Scooters are not permitted to be used on the venue.
14. Speed limits must be always adhered to, the speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h.
15. Power leads must not be on the ground or over
16. Construction of portable/tape yards is
17. Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No 1.
18. Please observe all signs at the venue.
19. Horses must be tied in a safe manner. Horses must not be tied to unattached floats, wheelie bins etc.
20. No infrastructure to be erected on WPNEC Grounds without written approval by management prior to event.
21. Entry and exit doors to Indoors Arenas must not be obstructed at any time.
22. Every event to book at WPNEC must provide their own first aid officials.
23. Report any incidents, damages, or safety concerns to WPNEC management immediately.
24. Dogs are not permitted on the Cross-Country Course when in use.
25. Please call WPNEC Management should you require any assistance with ANY Issue.
26. Users who do not comply with these guidelines may be refused future use of WPNEC
