COMPETITION INFORMATION

The **Yulong Stud Rising Stars** provides owners the opportunity to showcase the potential of their recently retired racehorse. The judges will be looking for potential for the future: an athletic, free moving horse with a promising jumping technique and attitude, which with correct training will develop physically and mentally into a good eventing horse.

INTRODUCTION

Supported by Yulong Stud and conducted by the Melbourne International 3 Day Event Committee (on behalf of Eventing Victoria) in accordance with EA Guidelines.

Competition date: Friday 5 June 2026

Timetables (including Arena familiarisation) will be posted after close of entries. It is highly recommended competitors attend the Arena familiarisation.

Competitors please note: All riders are required to check in at the Event Office upon arrival to the venue at Werribee Park. Riders will receive two Friday passes for event access.

Riders must have a minimum of Participant membership with Equestrian Australia.

PRESENTATIONS:

At the conclusion of each class the top six horses will be invited for presentation.

ENTRY FEE:

\$160 per horse: includes medical levy & admin. fee
WPNEC Facility Fee: \$20 per day of stay

Friday evening - Spit Roast \$26 (3-4 meats with salads, rolls, desserts)

Spit Roast in Indoor 1 – Bar Opens/bar prices 6.00pm. Tickets may be purchased when entering.

Entry fee includes 2 Friday access passes to MI3DE.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and may be restricted if the class is oversubscribed.

SCRATCHING & REFUND POLICY:

Full refund of Entry Fee less \$30 Admin fee if scratched before 20 May 2026, 5pm.

50% of Entry Fee (less \$30 Admin fee) is refunded with a Vet. Certificate up until 5pm on Friday 29th May. No refunds after 5pm on Friday 29th May.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Dressage: to be held during the day on the sand dressage arenas. Each horse performs a dressage test to demonstrate obedience, suppleness and correct, elastic and regular gaits. Dressage test: MI3DE 4YO Young Horse Test which is included in this information and available to download on the MI3DE website. Note: whips may be carried during the dressage

Jumping: will be held in Indoor 1 late afternoon/early evening. The course will be a combination of solid obstacles & show jumps. A hand gallop will also be expected. Jump height maximum 80cm

The winner will have the highest overall marks from the two sections.

Saddlery & Dress:

Saddlery: As per EA Eventing Rule 539.2, 539.3. Dress: As per EA Eventing Rule 538.2, 538.4 for dressage and jumping. Back protectors to be worn for jumping. Bridle numbers to be worn. *Approved safety helmets are to be worn in all ridden phases.

General Conditions:

- Competitions are conducted under EA National guidelines
- All riders and owners must be EA registered, minimum participant membership
- Riders must turn 12 years of age or over in the calendar year of competition
- Tests may not be called
- The same judges will not necessarily officiate in each round
- All scratchings must be advised via email susan_mckay@bigpond.com

Competitors are bound by the Equestrian Australia (EA) General Regulations, applicable EA Sport Rules and all relevant EA Codes, policies, bylaws, rules and regulations.

Stable priority is given to the horses competing in the CCI Long Format classes, please contact MI3DE Secretary susan_mckay@bigpond.com to enquire about stable availability.

Overnight camping is available and must be booked and paid for at the time of entry. Powered sites are \$40 per night, Unpowered sites \$25 per night. Day visitors will park in the K Road parking area.

Cancellation and Refund

EV or the Organising Committee may cancel the event due to catastrophic conditions, disease or force majeure, or for any other reason at its absolute discretion.

If the event is cancelled after it has commenced there will be no refunds. If the event is cancelled prior to commencement the entrant may be entitled to a proportional refund of the entry fees paid. Any such refund will be determined at the absolute discretion of EV, having regard to the direct or fixed costs for the event.

Entrants who have provided with their entry an email address and/or mobile phone number will be notified of event cancellation by email and/or text message.

Release and Indemnity:

You acknowledge that horse riding, working with or being around horses can be dangerous. Horses can act in sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt. As a consequence, there is a real risk of damage to property, serious injury or even death.

In consideration of acceptance of your entry and participation in the event you agree to release and forever discharge EA, EV, their servants and agents and the Organising Committee and each member thereof from all claims, proceedings or demands for any loss or damage howsoever arising from any accident or incident occurring at the event.

In consideration of acceptance of your entry and participation in the event, you agree to indemnify and keep indemnified EA, EV, their servants and agents and the Organising Committee and each member thereof against all claims, proceedings or demands brought by or on behalf of any participant or competitor named in your entry form for any loss or damage howsoever arising from any accident or incident occurring at the event.

Child Safe Event

All Equestrian Victoria competitions are governed under Victoria's Child Safe Legislation. It is expected of all competitors, parents and spectators to participate under these guidelines.
